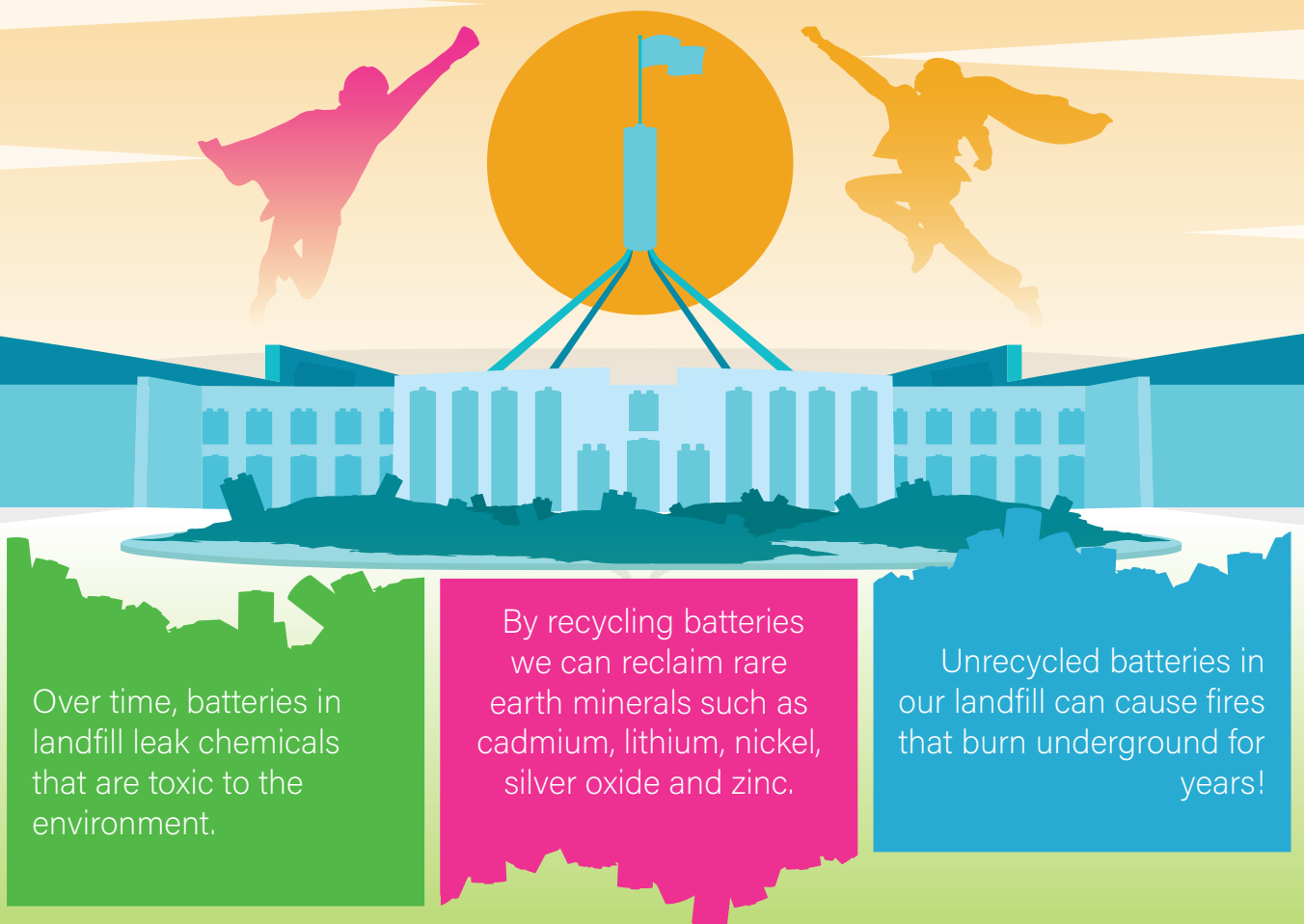


SAVE THE PLANET!

Over time, batteries in landfill leak chemicals that are toxic to the environment.

By recycling batteries we can reclaim rare earth minerals such as cadmium, lithium, nickel, silver oxide and zinc.

Unrecycled batteries in our landfill can cause fires that burn underground for years!
